The ALS Society of New Brunswick and Nova Scotia is a non-profit organization committed to supporting families on the ALS journey through services such as the Equipment Loan Program. The ALS Society is able to provide this service at no cost to families because of the generosity of our donors. Our resources are limited, and we may not always be able to provide the exact equipment requested. Our goal is to keep people with ALS comfortable, safe, mobile, and breathing. The Client Services Team will work with healthcare professionals to find the right solution for the person with ALS, while working within our capacity and limited resources. Thank you for your understanding.

The ALS Society of New Brunswick and Nova Scotia does not have the resources to trial equipment. Once we deliver equipment to a person with ALS, it is theirs until they no longer need it. Once a healthcare professional has determined their client's needs, an equipment loan form must be filled out and returned before the Client Services Team can begin the process of getting the right piece of equipment to the client. The Equipment Loan Program is on a first come, first serve basis and equipment will not be reserved for clients until a completed equipment loan form is submitted.

The ALS Society of New Brunswick and Nova Scotia does not loan equipment to clients in nursing homes where the equipment is already provided. The ALS Society will provide equipment that cannot be sourced from the nursing home. For example, mobility and breathing equipment.

All servicing/repairs/modifications on any piece of equipment must go through our Client Services Manager, Terri Cooper. The ALS Society of New Brunswick and Nova Scotia covers the cost of servicing for regular wear and tear. Clients are loaned equipment with the understanding that each piece of equipment will be properly maintained and taken care of. The Client Services Team at the ALS Society will ensure both the healthcare professional and the client are aware of maintenance protocol. Servicing for equipment that has not been properly taken care of will be at the expense of the client. For example, a power wheelchair's batteries must be kept sufficiently charged. If a power wheelchair needs a battery replacement because of failure to keep charged, the client is expected to cover those costs.
